1Chronicles 12:32 the sons of Issachar who had understanding of the times, to know what Israel ought to do,

Ecclesiastes 3:1,2 To everything there is a season, A time for every purpose under heaven: A time to be born, And a time to die; A time to plant, And a time to pluck what is planted;

Exodus 23:17 "Three times in the year all your males shall appear before the Lord God.

Exodus 16:1 And they journeyed from Elim, and all the congregation of the children of Israel came to the Wilderness of Sin, which is between Elim and Sinai, on the fifteenth day of the second month after they departed from the land of Egypt.

Exodus 17:8-10 Now Amalek came and fought with Israel in Rephidim. And Moses said to Joshua, "Choose us some men and go out, fight with Amalek. Ruth 1:16-18 And Ruth said: 'Entreat me not to leave thee, and to return from following after you; for where you go, I will go; and where you lodge, I will lodge; your people shall be my people, and your God my God; where you die, will

I die, and there will I be buried; the LORD do so to me, and more also, if anything but death part you and me.'

Obadiah 1:10,11 "For violence against your brother Jacob, Shame shall cover you, And you shall be cut off forever. In the day that **you stood on the other side**— In the day that strangers carried captive his forces, When foreigners entered his gates And cast lots for Jerusalem—Even you were as one of them.

Obadiah 1:14 You should not have **stood at the crossroads** To cut off those among them who escaped; Nor should you have delivered up those among them who remained In the day of distress.

Obadiah 1:15 "For the day of the Lord upon all the nations is near; **As you have done**, **it shall be done to you**; Your reprisal shall return upon your own head.

Gen 12:2 "I will make your name great!"

Genesis 12:7 The LORD appeared to Abram and said, "I will give this land to your seed." He built an altar there to the LORD, who appeared to him.

Ruth 4:5 Then Boaz said, "On the day you buy the field from the hand of Naomi, you must buy it also from Ruth the Moabitess, the wife of the dead, <u>to raise up the</u> <u>name of the dead</u> on his inheritance."

Numbers 14:10-12 But all the congregation bade stone them with stones. And the glory of the LORD appeared in the tabernacle of the congregation before all the children of Israel. And the LORD said unto Moses, How long will this people provoke me? and how long will it be ere they believe me, for all the signs which I have showed among them? Numbers 14:17-21 "And now, I pray, <u>let the power of my Lord be</u> great, just as You have spoken, saying, <u>'The LORD is longsuffering and abundant in mercy,</u> forgiving iniquity and transgression; but He by no means clears the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children to the third and fourth generation.' "Pardon the iniquity of this people, I pray, according to the <u>greatness</u> of Your mercy, just as You have forgiven this people, from Egypt even until now." Then the LORD said: "I have pardoned, according to your word; "but truly, as I live, all the earth shall be filled with **the glory of the LORD**-

Ezekiel 36:20-24 And when they came unto the nations, whither they came, they profaned My holy name; in that men said of them: These are the people of the LORD, and are gone forth out of His land. But I had pity for My holy name, which the house of Israel had profaned among the nations, whither they came. Therefore say unto the house of Israel: Thus saith the Lord GOD: I do not this for your sake, O house of Israel, but for My holy name, which ye have profaned among the nations, whither ye came. And I will sanctify My great name, which hath been profaned among the nations, which ye have profaned in the midst of them; and the nations shall know that I am the LORD, saith the Lord GOD, when I shall be sanctified in you before their eyes. For I will take you from among the nations, and gather you out of all countries, and will bring you into your own land.

Genesis 7:1 And the LORD said unto Noah: 'Come thou and all thy house into the ark; for thee have I seen righteous before Me in **this generation**.

Genesis 15:16 And in the **fourth generation** they shall come back hither; for the iniquity of the Amorite is not yet full.'

Deuteronomy 32:20 And He said: 'I will hide My face from them, I will see what their end shall be; for they are a very froward **generation**, children in whom is no faithfulness.

Psalm 24:6 Such is the generation of them that seek after Him, that seek Thy face, even Jacob.

Proverbs 30:11-14 There is a generation that curse their father, and do not bless their mother. **There is a generation** that are pure in their own eyes, and yet are not washed from their filthiness. **There is a generation**, Oh how lofty are their eyes! and their eyelids are lifted up. **There is a generation** whose teeth are as swords, and their great teeth as knives, to devour the poor from off the earth, and the needy from among men.

Mark 9:19 He answered him and said, "O faithless generation, how long shall I be with you? How long shall I bear with you?

Luke 18:8 Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"

Matthew 8:10 When Yeshua heard it, He marveled, and said to those who followed, "Assuredly, I say to you, I have not found such great faith, not even in Israel!

Genesis 2:4 These are the <u>generations</u> of the heavens and of the earth when they were created, <u>in the day</u> that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens,

Genesis 5:1 This is the book of the generations of Adam.

Ruth 4:18 Now these are the generations of Pharez:

Ruth 4:21,22 And Salmon begat Boaz, and Boaz begat Obed, And Obed begat Jesse, and Jesse begat <u>David</u>.

Matthew 1:1 The book of the <u>generations</u> of Yeshua HaMashiach, <u>the son of</u> <u>David</u>, the son of Abraham.

Acts 15:15-17 And with this the words of the prophets agree, just as it is written: 'After this I will return And will rebuild the tabernacle of David, which has fallen down; I will rebuild its ruins, And I will set it up; So <u>that the rest of mankind</u> may seek the Lord, Even all the Gentiles who are called by My name, Says the Lord who does all these things.'

Ezekiel 28:25,26 'Thus says the Lord God: "When I have gathered the house of Israel from the peoples among whom they are scattered, and I am hallowed in them in the sight of the Gentiles, then they will dwell in their own land which I gave to My servant Jacob. And they will dwell safely there, build houses, and plant vineyards; yes, they will dwell securely, when I execute judgments on all those around them who despise them. Then they shall know that I am the Lord their God."

Amos 9:14,15 I will bring back the captives of My people Israel; They shall build the waste cities and inhabit them; They shall plant vineyards and drink wine from them; They shall also make gardens and eat fruit from them. I will plant them in their land, <u>And no longer shall they be pulled up From the land I have given</u> <u>them</u>," Says the Lord your God.

Ezekiel 36:35-37 And they shall say: This land that was desolate is become like the garden of Eden; and the waste and desolate and ruined cities are fortified and inhabited. Then <u>the nations that are left round about you shall know</u> that I the LORD have builded the ruined places, and planted that which was desolate; I the LORD have spoken it, and I will do it. Thus saith the Lord GOD: I will yet for this be inquired of by the house of Israel, to do it for them; I will increase them with men like a flock.

Ezekiel 36:38 As the flock for sacrifice, as the flock of Jerusalem in her appointed seasons, so shall the waste cities be filled with flocks of men; and they shall know that I am the LORD.'

Matthew 24:6-8 You will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you aren't troubled, for all this must happen, but the end is not yet. For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom; and there will be famines, plagues, and earthquakes in various places. But all these things are the beginning of birth pains.

Matthew 24:32-34 "<u>Now from the fig tree learn this parable</u>. When its branch has now become tender, and <u>puts forth its leaves</u>, you know that the summer is near. Even so you also, when you see all these things, know that it is near, even at the doors. Most certainly I tell you, <u>this generation will not pass away</u>, until all these things are accomplished.

Matthew 24:37 "<u>As the days of Noah</u> were, so will be the coming of the Son of Man.

Genesis 6:3 The LORD said, "My Spirit will not strive with man forever, because he also is flesh; yet will <u>his days be one hundred twenty years</u>."

Genesis 15:13-16 And He said unto Abram: 'Know of a surety that thy seed shall be a stranger in a land that is not theirs, and shall serve them; and they shall afflict them **four hundred years**; and also that nation, whom they shall serve, will I judge; and afterward shall they come out with great substance. But thou shalt go to thy fathers in peace; thou shalt be buried in a good old age. And in <u>the fourth</u> **generation** they shall come back hither; for the iniquity of the Amorite is not yet full.'

Genesis 7:11 In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, <u>in the second month, on the</u> <u>seventeenth day of the month</u>, on the same day all the fountains of the great deep were burst open, and the sky's windows were opened.

Psalm 90:10 The days of our years are threescore years and ten,

Leviticus 25:10 And ye shall hallow the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout the land unto all the inhabitants thereof; it shall be a jubilee unto you; and <u>ye shall return every man unto his possession</u>, and ye shall return every man unto <u>his family</u>.

Psalm 102:13 You will arise and have mercy on Zion; for it is time to have pity on her. Yes, the <u>set time</u> has come.

Psalm 102:16 When ההוה shall build up Zion, he shall appear in his glory.

Psalm 102:18 This shall be written for the **generation to come**; and **a people which shall be created** shall praise the LORD.

Jeremiah 31:31 Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel, and with the house of Judah;

Malachi 4:4-6 Remember the Law of Moses, My servant, Which I commanded him in Horeb for all Israel, With the statutes and judgments. Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet Before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the Lord. And he will turn The hearts of the fathers to the children, And the hearts of the children to their fathers, Lest I come and strike the earth with a curse."

Jeremiah 16:19,20 O Lord, my strength and my fortress, My refuge in the day of affliction, The Gentiles shall come to You From the ends of the earth and say, "Surely our fathers have inherited lies, Worthlessness and unprofitable things." Will a man make gods for himself, Which are not gods?

Isaiah 54:9-11 "For this is <u>like the waters of Noah to me</u>; for as I have sworn that the waters of Noah shall no more go over the earth, so have I sworn that I will not be angry with you, nor rebuke you. For the mountains may depart, and the hills be removed; but my loving kindness shall not depart from you, <u>neither shall my</u> covenant of peace be removed," says the LORD who has mercy on you. **Psalms 105:8-11** He has remembered his covenant <u>forever</u>, the word which he commanded to <u>one thousand generations</u>. Which covenant he made with Abraham, and his oath unto Isaac; And confirmed the same to Jacob for a law, and to Israel for an <u>everlasting covenant</u>: Saying, <u>to you will I give the land of Canaan, the lot of your inheritance.</u>

Jeremiah 31:35-37 Thus says the LORD, who gives the sun for a light by day, and the ordinances of the moon and of the stars for a light by night, who stirs up the sea, so that its waves roar; the LORD of Hosts is his name: If these ordinances depart from before me, says the LORD, then the seed of Israel also shall cease from being a nation before me forever. Thus says the LORD: If heaven above can be measured, and the foundations of the earth searched out beneath, then will I also cast off all the seed of Israel for all that they have done, says the LORD.

Genesis 48:19,20 But his father refused and said, "I know, my son, I know. He also shall become a people, and he also shall be great; but truly his younger brother shall be greater than he, and his descendants shall become a multitude of nations." So he blessed them that day, saying, "By you Israel will bless, saying, 'May God make you as Ephraim and as Manasseh!' " And thus he set Ephraim before Manasseh.
